About this document

This document contains the redlined changes to the SEC that would be required to deliver this Modification Proposal.

Section A ‘Definitions and Interpretation’

These changes have been redlined against Section A version 20.0.

Add the following new definition to Section A:

Market Participant Identifier has the meaning given to that expression in the Retail Energy Code.

Section B 'Accession'

These changes have been redlined against Section B version 8.0.

Amend Section B 1.21 as follows:

Market Participant Identifiers

B1.21 The following shall apply in respect of the Market Participant Identifiers:

- (a) The Panel shall, as soon as reasonably practicable after a person becomes a Party, notify the DCC of the ~~Market Participant Unique~~ identifiers (if any) by which such person is identified under the UNC and/or BSC, as set out in the Party Details contained in the relevant Accession Agreement.
- (b) The Panel shall, as soon as reasonably practicable after a Party notifies any change or addition to such unique identifiers under Section M6 (Party Details), ~~or the Panel otherwise becoming aware of any such change or addition~~, notify the DCC of such change or addition.
- (c) the DCC shall use the information provided to it under this Section B1.21 to interpret the Registration Data and identify eligibility for Services; subject to Section L16.9 (Supplier of Last Resort).

Section L ‘Smart Metering Key Infrastructure and DCC Key Infrastructure’

These changes have been redlined against Section L version 12.0.

Amend Section 16.1 as follows:

L16.1 Where the Authority notifies the ~~DCC~~SMKI PMA of a Failing Energy Supplier, the ~~DCC~~SMKI PMA shall notify the ~~SMKI PMA~~DCC, and the following shall apply: [...]

Add Section 16.9 as follows:

L16.9 Where the SMKI PMA directs the DCC not to revoke one or more of the Failing Energy Supplier’s Supplier Certificates, the SMKI PMA shall also direct the DCC not to recognise the transfer of the Failing Energy Supplier’s Market Participant Identifiers to the Supplier of Last Resort, where this will assist in enabling the Shared Resource Provider to take steps required by this Section L16.1. The DCC shall comply with each such direction until the SMKI PMA or the Authority directs otherwise.
