1. Purpose

2.1 Recommended for approval as a Fast-Track Modification

Proposal	Recommendations
DP249 'Housekeeping Changes for the November 2023 SEC Release'	AGREE the issue and the impact it is having is clearly defined and understood AGREE that DP249 should be converted to a Modification Proposal AGREE that MP249 should be progressed and approved as a Fast-Track Modification (<i>the CSC must be unanimous for this to be passed</i>) APPROVE the Modification Report APPROVE the implementation approach

We recommend that DP249 is progressed and approved as a Fast Track Modification. This change is proposing to correct minor errors and inconsistencies with the SEC, and we believe this meets the criteria in SEC Section D2.8 to be a Fast Track Modification.

The CSC must be unanimous to progress and approve a modification as a Fast Track Modification. Parties will then have a 15 Working Day period in which they can object to the CSC's decision. If no objections are received, the CSC's approval of the change will be final.
