SEC Modification Progression – June 2024

1. Purpose

2.1 Recommended for approval as a Fast-Track Modification

Proposal	Recommendations
DP269 'June 2024 SEC Release Supporting Changes'	AGREE the issue and the impact it is having is clearly defined and understood AGREE that DP269 should be converted to a Modification Proposal APPROVE the Modification Report APPROVE the implementation approach AGREE that MP269 should be approved as a Fast-Track Modification (<i>the CSC must be unanimous for this to be passed</i>)

We recommend that DP269 is progressed and approved as a Fast Track Modification. This change is proposing to make a minor change to the legal text of [MP256 'SEC Alignment with DCC SMETS1 MHHS Capacity Requirements'](#). The change will clarify that DCC Users can retrieve data logs from SMETS1 Devices from 'Day' periods outside that of just the previous 'Day' period.

The CSC must be unanimous to progress and approve a modification as a Fast Track Modification. Parties will then have a 15 Working Day period in which they can object to the CSC's decision. If no objections are received, the CSC's approval of the change will be final.
