

■ DP316 'DUIS 12.2 PRE-NOTIFICATION OF CHF AMBIGUITY'

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Raised by David Walsh from the DCC

Progress to Report Phase

LOW

Overview

- DUIS does not specify the error code expected if the sender of the SR erroneously specifies both the CHF and the GPF IDs to be the same value
- The DCC send a Response Code E120201 in the event when an SR 12.2 is sent by a User
- The E120201 Response Code does not cover the duplication of the CHF Device ID nor is it descriptive of the problem

Issue



- Doing nothing means ambiguity remains within DUIS
- Users are unsure of the expected behaviour and DSP2 could produce a different error in this scenario

Impact



- To make text only change to SEC Appendix AD (DUIS) with the aim of providing clarity and to avoid any ambiguity and misinterpretation
