Decision, Discussion and Information Items

1. Previous Meeting's Minutes (For Decision) (**GREEN**)

The CTG reviewed the Confidential and Non-Confidential Minutes from the CTG 33 meeting, noting one amendment to the Confidential Minutes.

The CTG **APPROVED** both sets of minutes as final.

2. Actions Log Update (For Decision) (**RED**)

The CTG **NOTED** the actions log update and **AGREED** to close **CTG 33/01**.

3. DCC Update: 4G CH Programme Update (For Information) (**AMBER**)

The DCC noted that 4G CH installations were just over 600k and also provided a view of the Trust Centre Swap Out (TCSO) volumes. The DCC discussed global logistics in light of recent geopolitical events and confirmed that the risk is being monitored, and the supply chain continuity is currently being maintained.

CTG members shared feedback that future reporting must focus on actionable insights, such as operational and cost implications, and the DCC **AGREED** to review its reporting.

The CTG **NOTED** the update.

4. DCC Update: Long-Range Radio Committed Term (LRR CT) (For Endorsement) (**AMBER**)

The DCC provided an overview of the DCC's proposal for Long-Range Radio Committed Term (LRR CT), outlining the strategic, technical and contractual considerations.

The DCC presented the LRR CWG Statement and recommended it for endorsement to the SEC Panel. The DCC and SEC Industry Operations invited questions from all attendees, and provided clarifications and explanations.

The TABASC, OPSG and DCC attendees left the meeting for the CTG's discussion of its Committee view.

The CTG provided **ENDORSEMENT** to the LRR CWG Statement and **NOTED** caveats and questions raised by CTG Members that will be fed back to the DCC's LRR team.

5. DCC Update: VMO2 2G/3G Inbound Roaming Services Withdrawal (For Information) (GREEN)

The DCC presented an update on the timeline for withdrawal of SMETS1 2G Inbound Roaming Services.

The CTG discussed the primary challenges involved with Device swap outs, including gaining access to customer premises and availability of suitable WAN coverage.

The DCC **AGREED** to include the WAN coverage within its Supplier reporting.

SEC Industry Operations discussed the need for holistic reporting suite that covers all relevant roaming end dates, volumes, and service continuity risks, including both current and future cohorts. The DCC **AGREED** to investigate this and bring this report to a future CTG meeting.

The CTG **NOTED** the update.

6. CTG Risks and Issues Register – Monthly Update (For Decision) (RED)

SEC Industry Operations shared a monthly update on the CTG Risks and Issues Register and confirmed that baselined changes to the Register have been incorporated into draft v32.1.

SEC Industry Operations noted there were no new Risks added, no changes to the Risk ratings, and no Risks closed.

The CTG **AGREED** to the baselining of the Risks and Issues Register draft as v33.0.

7. CTG Overall Transition Plan (OTP) and Plan-on-a-page (POAP) Update (For Decision) (AMBER)

SEC Industry Operations shared the latest versions of the CTG Overall Transition Plan (OTP) and the Plan-on-a-Page (POAP) documents.

SEC Industry Operations noted key updates to the OTP include the 3G Sunsetting and a new milestone for 4G Coverage.

The CTG **AGREED** to baseline the OTP as v1.14 and POAP as v1.14.

8. AOB (For Discussion) (CLEAR)

SEC Industry Operations proposed scheduling a CTG X meeting after the Easter holidays to review the initial DCC Service Availability Statement and to discuss reporting updates.
