NOTICE TO MODIFY - Migration Testing Approach Document for SMETS1 Services (MTAD)

This letter notifies the modification of the Migration Testing Approach Document for SMETS1 Services (MTAD) which is included as an Annex to this letter.

BACKGROUND

In December 2022, DCC consulted¹ on a SMETS1 matter related to decommissioning of the Migration DUST testing service for the MOC (Secure) cohort via amendments to the MTAD. This letter covers a modification to the MTAD.

The consultation period ran from 5 December 2022 to 13 January 2023. DCC submitted a conclusions report to the Secretary of State, along with an amended MTAD following this consultation, on 18 January 2023, pursuant to Clause 4.2 in the SEC Variation Testing Approach Document for SMETS1 Services (SMETS1 SVTAD). DCC's conclusions in light of this consultation have been published on the DCC Website².

DECISION

Following submission of the conclusions report, the Secretary of State confirmed to DCC that he will not be directing DCC not to modify the MTAD.

DCC is therefore issuing this notice to modify the MTAD on Friday 27 January 2023.

DCC has notified the SEC Administrator and provided an updated version of the MTAD which will be available on the SEC website in due course.

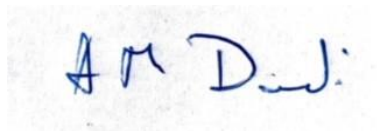
NOTIFICATION

Pursuant to Clause 4.2 of Appendix AK of the SEC (the SEC Variation Testing Approach Document for SMETS1 Services), DCC directs that, with effect from 27 January 2023, the Migration Test Approach Document is hereby modified in the form set out in Annex A of this direction.

For the avoidance of doubt such modification of the Migration Test Approach Document shall be without prejudice to anything done under the DCC Licence or the SEC on or after this first being established, or to the continuing effectiveness of anything done under this document prior to its modification (which shall have effect as if done under the modified document).

This direction is also being notified to the SEC Administrator.
