

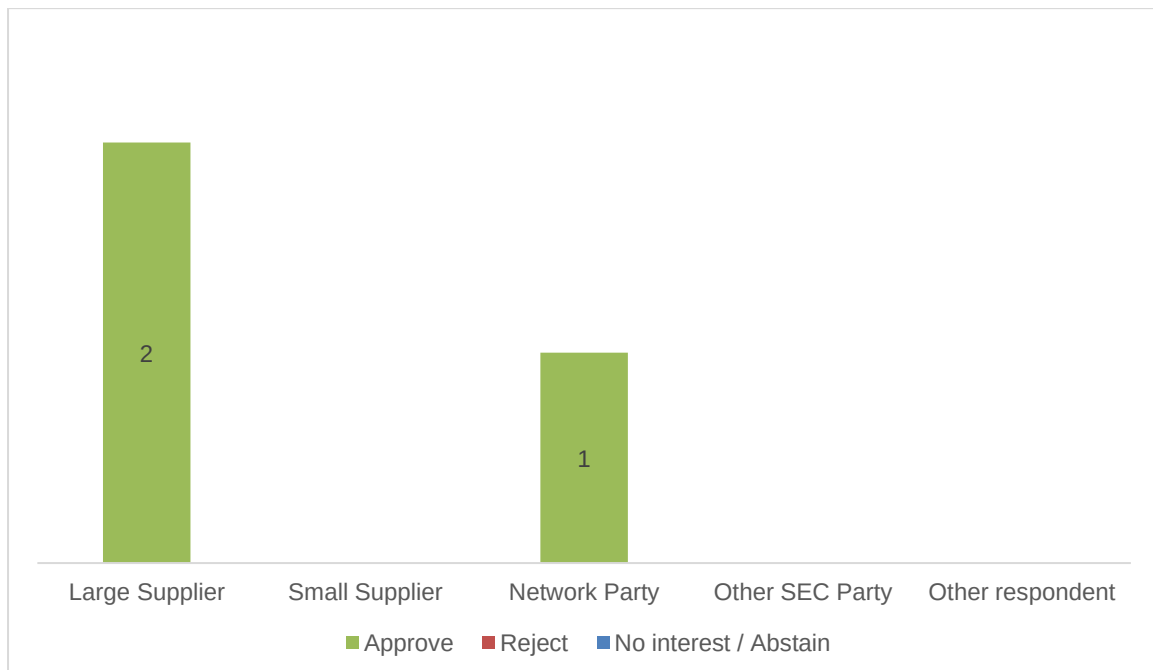

Although we agree the need to move the dates in line with the reasons presented, why do they not line up with the dates applied in MP191?	The 18-month extension is due to DCC estimates of CHTS v1.1 and GBCS v2.0 Communications Hub lasting for around another 20 months at the rates currently experienced, hence the 18-month extension.
