

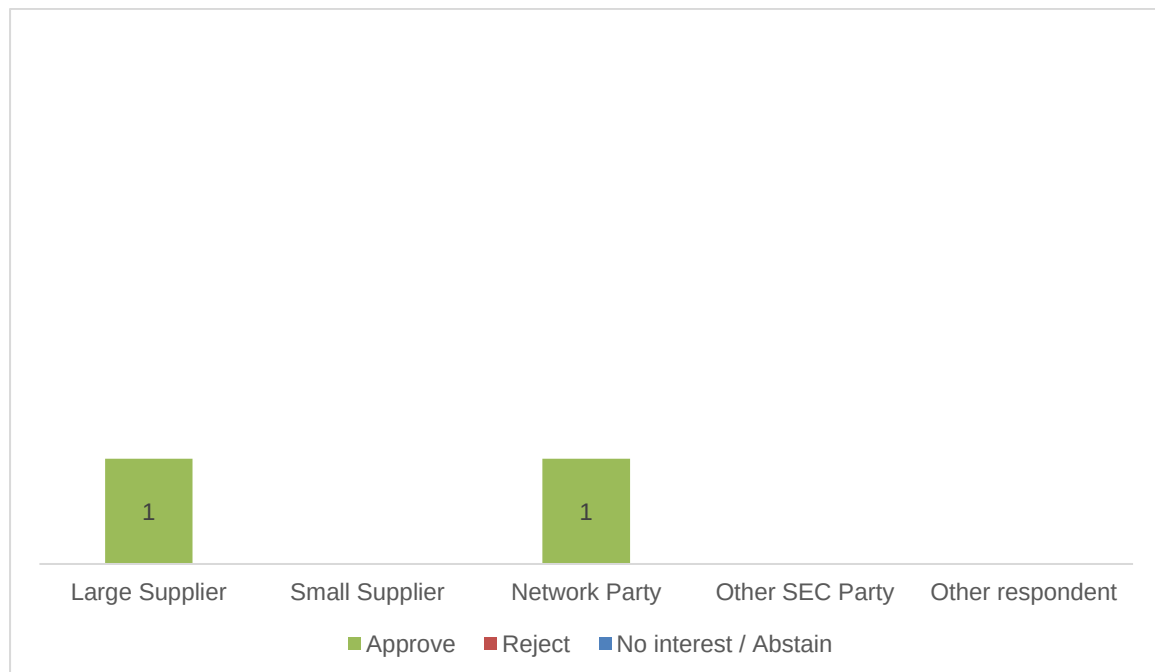
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MP279 ‘June 2025 SEC Releases & DUIS Housekeeping Changes’ Modification Report Consultation responses

National Grid Electricity Distribution	Network Party	1. There are a number of instances throughout the legal text, stating 'Error! Reference source not found. (Error! Reference source not found)', seemingly wherever it refers to a clause. 2. There appears to be a space missing on the title of section 1.4.7.14 between 1.4.7.14 and the word 'Activate'. 3. There appears to be a space missing on the title of section 1.4.11.2 between 1.4.11.2 and the word 'Countersigned'. 4. On page 21 of the legal text, under the heading of '3.8.43.2 Specific Data Items for this Request', the description of data item 'Choice of Service Request XML Element to be Scheduled' shows the Read Instantaneous Import Registers being amended to Export. Should there in fact be an Import and an Export? Basically scheduling either the "4.1.1 Read Instantaneous Import Registers" or the "4.2 Read Instantaneous Export Registers" SRVs. 5. At the top of page 11 of Annex A – MP279 legal text – there appears to be the following amendment required: 'N11 for DCC Scheduled Service Request is if a S1SP N55 alert is already generated indicating failure of that DCC Scheduled Request', in line with the other bullet points above.	SECAS have reached out to the respondent explaining the error was due to the export conversion of the document from word to pdf. The redlining markup is also included in the legal text to show the before and after changes. The respondent has advised they sent the comment after they had seen the correction and would like SECAS to disregard their comment.
