This document summarises the responses received to the Modification Report Consultation regarding approval or rejection of this modification.

Summary of conclusions

Modification Report Consultation

The Smart Energy Code Administrator and Secretariat (SECAS) received two responses to the Modification Report Consultation. Both respondents believed that the modification should be approved. One respondent considered the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (f)¹. The other respondent did not express a view on which SEC Objective would be better facilitated by this modification.

Modification Report Consultation responses

Summary of responses

One respondent believed the modification should be approved, however there were caveats to the approval, as the respondent believed further review should be carried out with regard to the legal text. The respondent highlighted that the legal text should reflect the Data that the Data Communications Company (DCC) Other Users should report breaches of. The text was subsequently amended to confirm that the Data to report breaches of is the Data DCC Other Users obtain as part of SEC Section I 'Data Privacy'.

The other respondent believed that the modification should be approved as it better facilitated SEC Objective (f).
