Summary of conclusions

Modification Report Consultation

SECAS received five responses to the Modification Report Consultation. All respondents believed that the modification should be approved. They considered the modification better facilitated SEC Objectives (a)¹ and (b)².

¹ Facilitate the efficient provision, installation, operation and interoperability of smart metering systems at energy consumers' premises within Great Britain.

² Enable the DCC to comply at all times with the objectives of the DCC licence and to discharge the other obligations imposed upon it by the DCC licence.

Modification Report Consultation responses

Summary of responses

All five respondents (two Large suppliers and three Network Parties) considered the modification better facilitated SEC Objectives (a) and (b) due to the efficiencies the removal of the Certificate Signing Request (CSR) forecasting process will deliver.

One respondent had comments regarding the DCC User Guidance Document, although SECAS has already addressed these in the latest version of the document.
