SECMP0006 Working Group Consultation Responses

The Working Group (WG) Consultation was issued on 4th April 2017 and closed on 27th April 2017. SECAS advised the WG that ten SEC Parties responded to the consultation. These respondents consisted of five Large Supplier Parties, four Other SEC Parties, and one Network Party.

The WG considered and addressed the responses received for each question. The key matters discussed included:

- comments on the number of display digits in the proposed solution;
- the suggestion of including the display of information on In Home Displays (IHDs) within scope of SECMP0006; and
- the respondents lead times and the recommended implementation approach.

The WG also discussed one Large Supplier's response which highlighted concerns regarding Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC) impacts as well as the processes required to ensure that the full values recorded on the Consumption Registers are submitted into settlement. The WG noted that these concerns had already been addressed through discussion at previous WG meetings. The WG agreed that SECAS should contact the Large Supplier to assist understanding. It was also agreed that SECAS should share the Large Supplier's concerns with ELEXON.

ACTION_MP06_1306_01 – SECAS to contact the Large Supplier Party to provide further information and offer assistance.

ACTION_MP06_1306_02 – SECAS to share the Large Supplier Party's BSC related concerns with ELEXON.
