We held 16 committee meetings in the month.

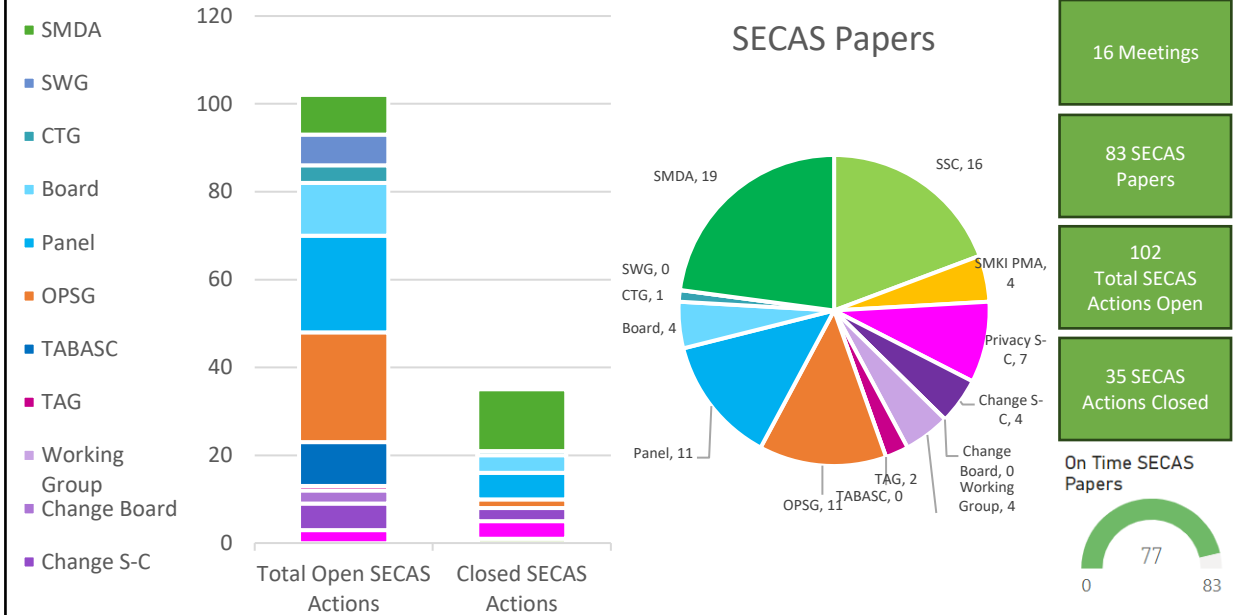

Four papers were submitted late to the SMDA Sub-Committee due to an unplanned absence within the SECAS team.

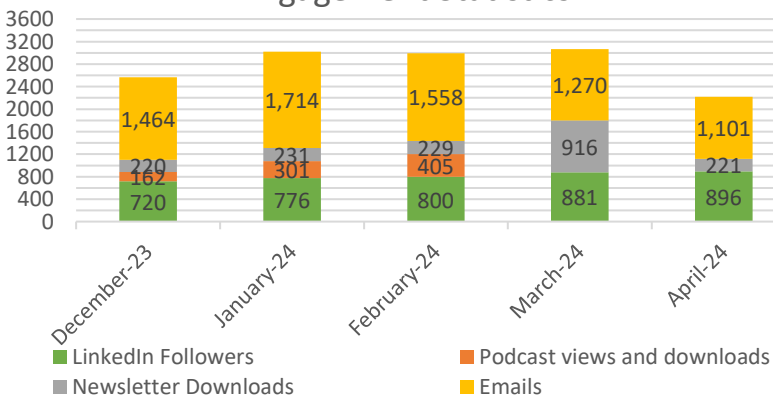

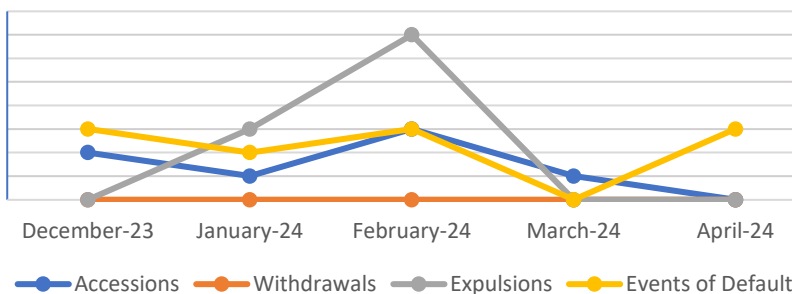
Party Engagement

Accessions, Withdrawals, Expulsions and Events of Default



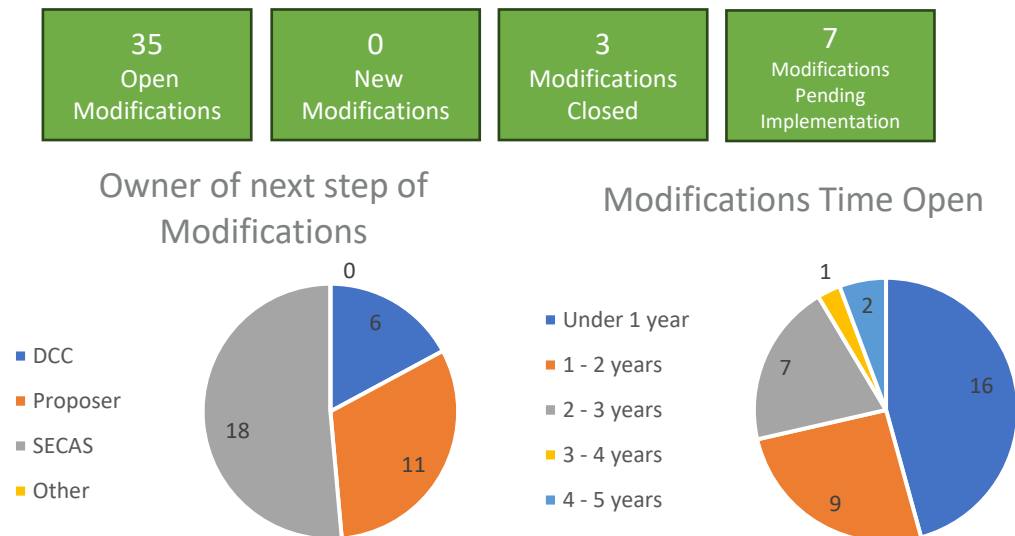
Webinars and Engagement Calls:

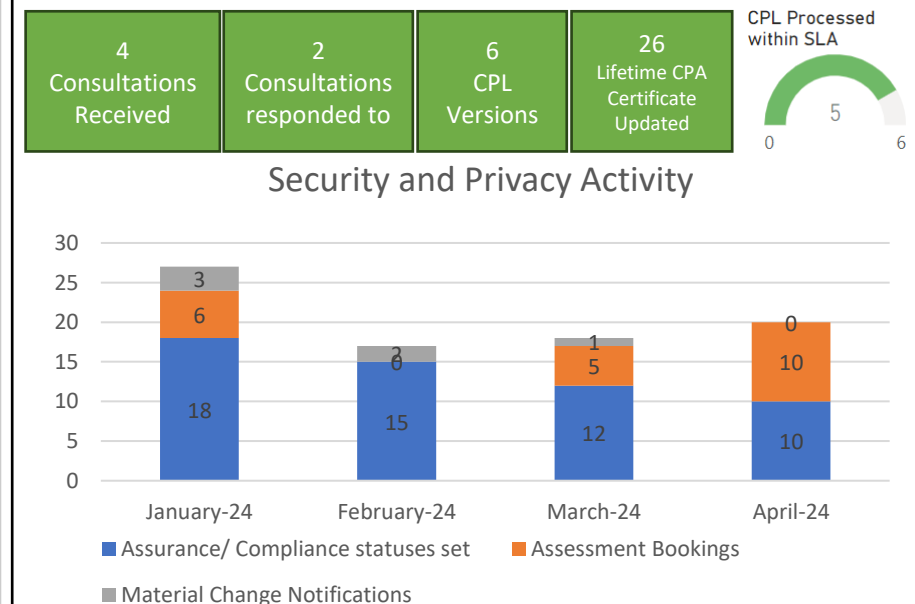
Technical

- Prepared and Submitted consultation responses to Ofgem on Code Reform and to DESNZ on their consultation on change to Commercial Product Assurance (CPA) Governance.
- Attended Ofgem workshops on DCC cost-control alongside SEC Panel members to support their development of the future ex-ante framework for DCC.
- A summary of responses and our response to feedback to the SMDA Review consultation was shared at SMDASC and SEC Panel.
- Identified further work to investigate feedback areas from TABASC Technical Effectiveness review.

Security & Privacy

- Engaged with DCC CIO to produce Lessons Learned from DCC security assessments in the last year.
- Engaged with User CIO on feedback from first three Triage Facility Provider security assessments.
- Facilitated call with SEC Panel/ SSC Chairs and ENO regarding feedback on Assessment Process and Approach for DNO Security Assessments. Meeting outcomes & actions shared with Panel/SSC.
- Issued SSC Briefing Note to alert smart metering parties and organisations to NCSC advice to take immediate action to mitigate against vulnerabilities affecting Cisco devices.
- Privacy Sub-Committee's 2nd meeting took place on 18 April with a high level of member engagement. Quarterly face-to-face meetings arranged. Risk Assessment project is on track.
