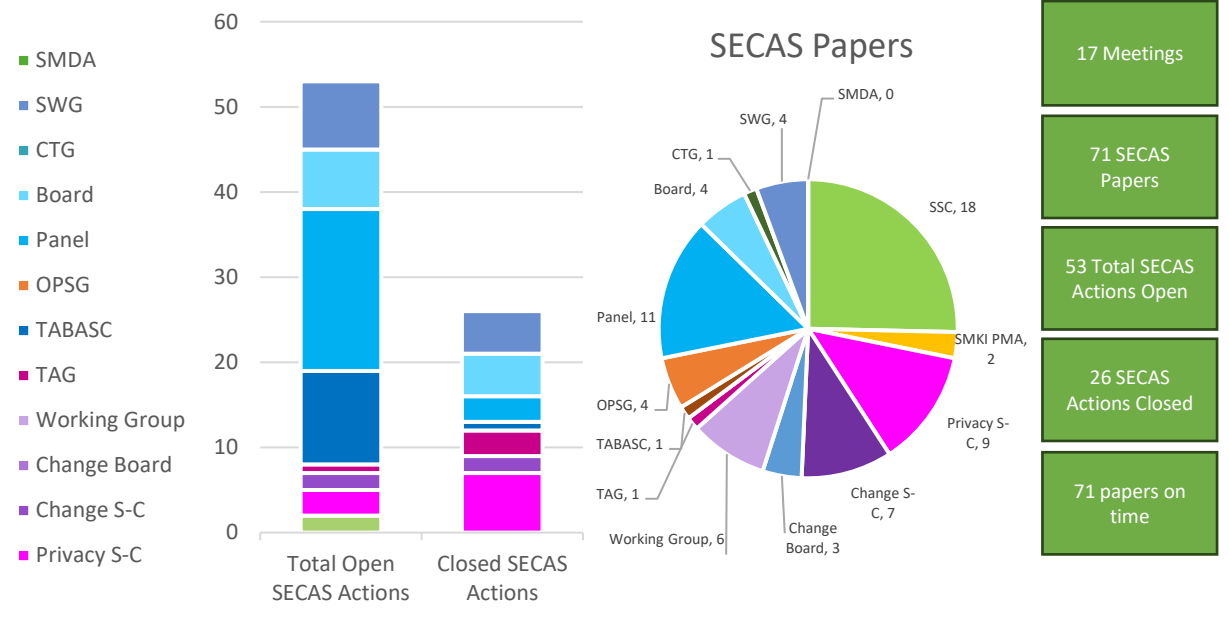


Meetings

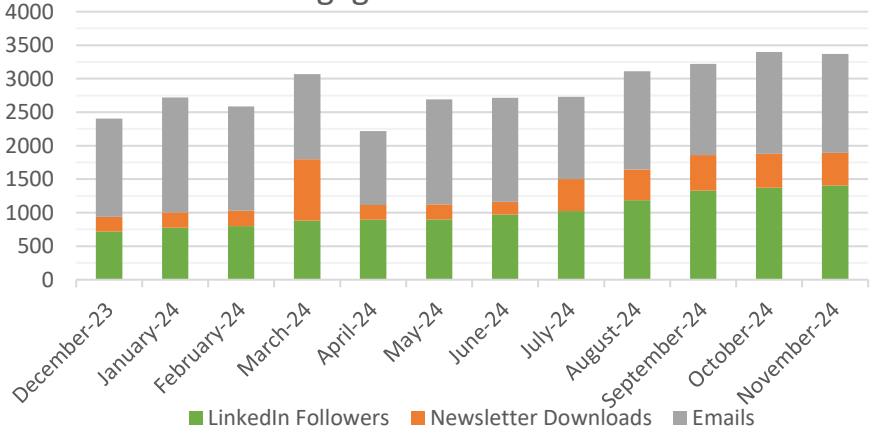

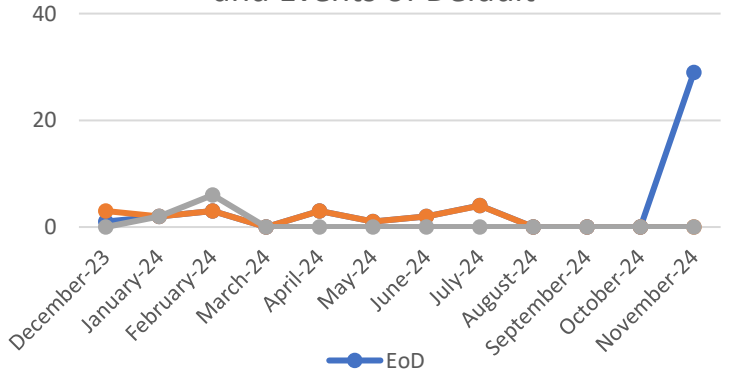

Accessions, Withdrawals, Expulsions and Events of Default



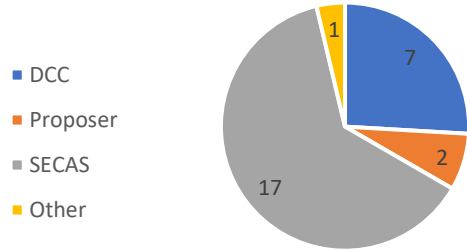
Party Engagement

 - 47 new followers

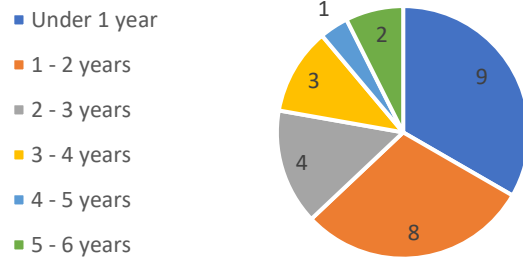
Change Modifications & Releases



Owner of next step of Modifications



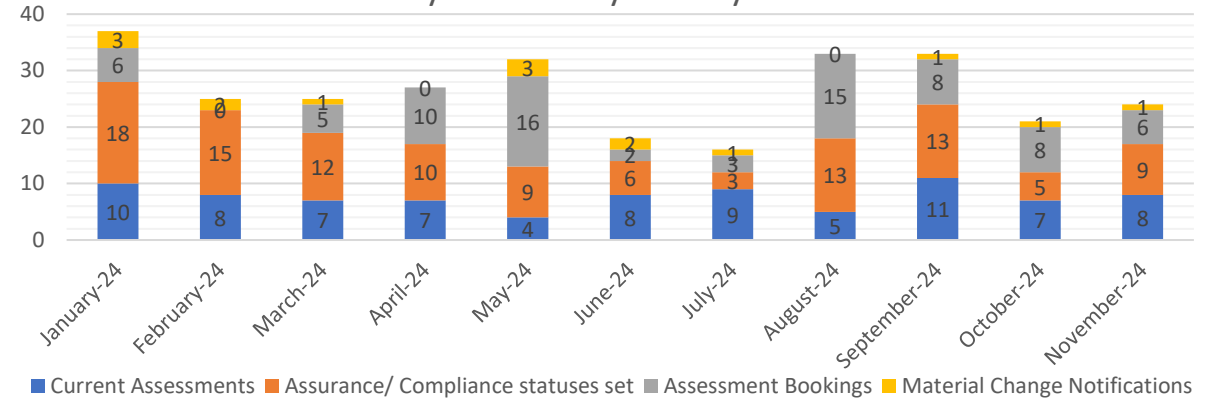
Modifications Time Open

Change Modifications

- We are working on 27 active modifications and have had 10 new issues raised in the last month
- Following the SECAS-led investigations into Release costs, the DCC has confirmed that they have saved £600k on the cost of the November 2024 SEC Release

Technical Operations

- We are preparing responses to 3 consultations received in November covering:
 - Ofgem's Annual Price Control for DCC (received 6 Nov)
 - Ofgem's consultation on Code Manager Selection under Energy Code Reform (received 28 Nov)
 - DESNZ consultation on updates to Appendix AV of the SEC (covering CPA arrangements) (received 15 Nov)
- We reviewed a fourth consultation relating to DESNZ's minded to position on the Baseline Margin Project Performance Adjustment for the DCC's CH&N programme, determining with SECCo that a response was not required
- We issued responses to consultations from DESNZ on DUIS Changes (responded 1 Nov) and proposals for the VWAN (responded 21 Nov), as well as to Ofgem's consultation on Innovation in Retail Market (responded 27 Nov)
- In the Technical Sub-Committees we support, we facilitated the consideration of DCC programmes including CH&N, DSP and FSM

Security & Privacy

- We facilitated the final Risk scoring and mitigation workshops with a sub-group of PSC members to complete the draft PSC Risk Register ready for approval at the PSC 09 Meeting
- We delivered 2 Webinars - Privacy Assessments and User Security Assessments
- We facilitated CPA Scheme Operator Contract finalisation and confirmed the appointment in the November SCIRS meeting
- We issued call for nominations for a new CPL Manufacturer role for SSC as part of the CPA Scheme ownership transfer
- Procurement for the Security Architecture Document review concluded and preferred bidder recommendation was approved by SEC Panel and Board.
- We issued AI Risks & Opportunities Project Report for initial feedback to PSC Members, SSC Chair, SEC Panel Chair and SECCo Head of Codes and Regulatory Strategy. The report is due to be shared with SSC and Panel members ahead of the December meetings.
