At each meeting, the Smart Metering Key Infrastructure Policy Management Authority (SMKI PMA) receives updates from the DCC, DESNZ and other Sub-Committees on matters of relevance to the SMKI arrangements.

- The DCC provided an update on DCC Key Custodians and the SMKI PMA agreed to assist the DCC in communications to request new volunteers from SEC Parties. (**GREEN**)

2. **MP268 Reporting Requirements (AMBER) (DCC)** The DCC provided an update on the reporting requirements to support the implementation of MP268, which the SMKI PMA noted.
3. **DCCKI CPS Approval (RED) (DCC)** The DCC advised that updates to the DCCKI Certification Practice Statement (CPS) will be provided for the next SMKI PMA meeting.
4. **FSM DCCKI SEC Changes (GREEN) (DCC)** The SMKI PMA noted a DCC update on the SEC changes needed regarding DCC Key Infrastructure (DCCKI) for Future Service Management (FSM).
5. **Apex Recovery Exercise (RED) (DCC)** The DCC provided an update on the upcoming Apex Recovery Exercise.
6. **CSR Criticality Flag Report (AMBER-STRICT) (DCC)** The DCC presented and update on criticality flags for Certificate Signing Requests (CSRs) noting that some Manufacturers are setting the criticality flag incorrectly and the SMKI PMA agreed to communicate this to Manufacturers.

- 7. New Draft Proposals and Modification Proposals (CLEAR)** (SECAS) SECAS presented the SMKI PMA with an update on new and ongoing Draft Proposals and Modification Proposals, which the SMKI PMA noted.
