Headlines of the Security Sub-Committee (SSC) 237_2204 – 22 April 2026

The SSC reviews the outcome for Users' and DCC Security Assessments and sets an Assurance status for Initial Full User Security Assessments (FUSAs), or a Compliance status for Verification User Security Assessments (VUSAs) and subsequent FUSAs. The SSC also reviews outstanding actions, monitors the risks to the Commercial Product Assurance (CPA) Certification of Devices, considers available updates from the DCC on the security implications of proposed changes and Anomaly Detection and any reported changes in Shared Resource Providers by Users and reported Security Incidents and Vulnerabilities.

The SSC set the Compliance Status for four Full User Security Assessments (FUSA), two Verification User Security Assessments (VUSA) and one Security Self-Assessments (SSA).

Matters Arising

The SSC noted Information on the Smart Meter Energy Data Repository (SMEDR), Sub-Committee Risk and Issue Management (SCRIM), SECCo Working Abroad Policy, Post-Quantum Computing Developments, SEC section G2.22 Discussion and Use of AI for meeting recording.

- 2a. **DCC LTE SMWAN – DCC CIO Security Assurance (FOR DECISION):** The SSC reviewed the DCC CIO Assessment for DCC LTW SMWAN. The SSC **NOTED** the assessment and set a compliance status. **(RED)**
- 2b. **DCC CIO Forward Look (FOR INFORMATION):** The DCC provided information on the DCC CIO Forward Look. The SSC **NOTED** the update. **(RED)**
4. **Risk Register (FOR DECISION):** SECAS shared detailed updates of the Risk Register. SSC Members provided feedback and **AGREED** proposed changes. **(RED)**
5. **SSC Guidance on Device Security Assurance and Triage (FOR DECISION):** The SSC Chair presented the SSC Guidance on Device Security Assurance and Triage. SSC considered proposed updates to 4G Comms Hub refurbishment guidance and **AGREED** to defer a decision until a future SSC meeting to allow time for a DCC risk assessment. **(RED)**
6. **CPA Matters (FOR DECISION):** The SSC Chair presented updates on CPA Matters including CPA Risk Reviews, Trial Device Applications and Build Standard Renewals. The SSC provided feedback and **AGREED** the outcomes and **AGREED** the SCIRS agenda. **(RED)**
7. **Long Range Radio Committed Term (FOR DECISION):** The DCC presented an overview of the Long Range Radio Committed Term Provisional Risk Assessment with a view of the impacts, risk assessment, timeline and cost estimates. The SSC **AGREED** with the proposed approach and **NOTED** the update. **(RED)**

8. **Anomaly Detection Report (FOR INFORMATION):** The DCC presented its six-monthly rolling Anomaly Detection Report and provided the SSC with a view of Anomaly Detection Threshold, Volume Observations and the setting of Global Thresholds. The SSC **NOTED** the report and provided feedback. (**RED**)
9. **Post Commissioning (FOR INFORMATION):** The DCC presented the monthly Post-Commissioning Report and gave an overview of PCO failures and Certificate rotation activity, which the SSC **NOTED**. (**RED**)
10. **FSM LSC (FOR DECISION):** The DCC presented an update on remediation of outstanding security aspects of the Future Service Management LSC Criteria and notified the deferral of the go-live date. Further updates will be provided at a future SSC meeting. (**AMBER**)
11. **FOC ANSO Engagement Plan (FOR INFORMATION):** The DCC presented the FOC ANSO Engagement Plan. The SSC **NOTED** the update. (**AMBER**)
12. **DESNZ Consultation (Reshaping Cyber Regulation in DGE) (FOR DECISION):** The SSC Chair presented questions from the DESNZ Consultation (Reshaping Cyber Regulation in DGE) and the SSC **AGREED** proposed responses with input from SECCO. (**AMBER**)
13. **Modifications Updates (FOR DISCUSSION):** SECAS shared two new modifications and shared updates on six modifications. The SSC **NOTED** the updates and provided feedback. (**GREEN**)
14. **Standing Agenda Items (FOR INFORMATION):** The SSC Chair noted that there were no Security Incidents and Vulnerabilities reported since the last SSC Meeting. The SSC Chair also noted that there are no UEP Updates. The SSC **NOTED** the updates. (**RED**)
