Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 107 Headlines on 7 November 2024

The following items were discussed:

- The DCC returned with a deep dive into the proposed DSP migration and Service User impacts across the various stages of migration. The TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC return to a future TABASC to provide further clarification on the queuing of responses and alerts during User transition, migration to the new DNS and the transfer of the Recovery capability to the new DSP (TABASC_107_0711_02).
- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on its progress on 4G CH&N LSC 1 & ICHIS. The TABASC **AGREED** to support LSC1 approval based on the information provided by DCC (TABASC_107_0711_03).
- SECAS presented an overview of TABASC Risks 14 and 20 for the TABASC to consider mitigations. The TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC provide a narrative as to the unreliability of the WAN status LED to indicate the presence of a viable WAN connection (TABASC_107_0711_04).
- The DCC provided an update on Future Service Management (FSM) Designs & SEC Changes and next steps. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_05).
- The DCC presented SMETS1 DCO Re-procurement Proposed Solution Design/HLA Designs and provided information on why this was the preferred option. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_06).
- The DCC provided a quarterly review on Northbound Prioritisation and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_07).
- The DCC presented an overview on DSP Major Incidents and minimising Change Related Service Outage Time. The TABASC **REQUESTED** the DCC to return with more information. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_08).
- SECAS presented TIRG Issue 5: Lack of diagnostic information when CH Exchange fails in Live. The TABASC **AGREED** to consider solutions and mitigations to this problem and to discuss further at a future meeting (TABASC_107_0711_10).
- SECAS presented MP273 'User Demand and Network Traffic Insights'. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_11).
- SECAS presented Virtual Gateway Connection and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_12).
- SECAS presented an update on the revised TSAT guidance note and agreed to update the diagrams and issue a new iteration of the document for approval. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_107_0711_13).
