- The DCC presented their 4G CH&N IPV Major Incident Brief and the TABASC were comfortable with the remedies that DCC has put in place to mitigate the risk of the same issue arising again (TABASC_111_0603_02).
- The DCC provided an update on the DSP Programme Plan and the TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC return with further clarification on the changes necessary for Modular DUIS transition and usage (TABASC_111_0603_03).
- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on its FSM Design programme and the TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC return with further information in relation to the proposed implementation date, any further changes with Single Sign-On (SSO)/Federation and a proposed SSO road map (TABASC_111_0603_04).
- The DCC presented an update on the DCO Re-procurement Solution Option and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_111_0603_05).
- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on Major Incidents and the TABASC **NOTED** their concern regarding the issues due to manual errors (TABASC_111_0603_06).
- The DCC provided an update on OCA Certificate Management and the TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC investigate and return with options that would not require all Suppliers to change their systems (TABASC_111_0603_07).
- The DCC presented an update on OCA Certificate Management (OCA Certificate Diversification) and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_111_0603_08).
- The DCC presented SMETS1 IOC: Retry Optimisation and the TABASC were supportive of the proposal and **NOTED** the update (TABASC_111_0603_09).
- SECAS presented MP281 'Install Codes in the SMI' and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_111_0603_12).
- SECAS presented MP282 'Removal of Registration Check for Suppliers using SR8.9 targeting SMETS2+ CHF' and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_111_0603_13).
- SECAS provided the TABASC with an update on the TABASC Effectiveness review and the TABASC **RECOMMENDED** that SECAS return with a proposal on how to progress workstream 4 and a proposal on options to revise and refresh the effectiveness review (TABASC_111_0603_14).
