■ MP294: Overview (1/3)

Issues

- No detail in SEC of allowable Unplanned Maintenance.
- Services delivered by DCC have grown (number of Service Providers / amount of change).
- No consideration is needed on activity that sits outside of Planned and Unplanned maintenance.

■ MP294: Overview (2/3)

Impacts

- Unplanned Maintenance could be perceived to be used to enable short notice User impacting work.
- No view of maintenance outside of the Planned/Unplanned activities.
- Increased complexity, less time available to complete post deployment, exacerbated by the new DSP service.

■ MP294: Overview (3/3)

Proposed Solution

- Review best practice for Unplanned Maintenance;
- Consider temporary additional allowance until new DSP is delivered.
- Introduction of 'Planned Resilience Maintenance', (not expected to impact services to Devices connected to 100,000+ Comms Hubs)
