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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 78 Headlines on 16 June 2022

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_78_1606_01).

The following items were also discussed:

- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Q2 Work Package. The TABASC **RECOMMENDED** the Q2 2022-23 Work Package to the SECCo Board for approval. (TABASC_78_1606_02)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with [DP204 – Incorporation of Category 3 IRPs into the SEC – Batch 3](#). The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_78_1606_03)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on [MP082 – 2.4GHz Channel Management](#). The TABASC discussed the validity of the business requirements and **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_78_1606_04)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the TABASC Quarterly Risk Register Update. The TABASC **NOTED** the update with further discussion to occur at TABASC 79. (TABASC_78_1606_06)
- SECAS provided a summary of the outcomes of the previous Effectiveness Review Survey, and asked the TABASC to approve the use of the same set of questions in the June 2022 survey. The TABASC **NOTED** the update and **AGREED** to use the proposed questions. (TABASC_78_1606_07)
- SECAS presented the proposed scope of work intended to deliver the impact assessment on BSC P430. TABASC **NOTED** the update and **AGREED** with the proposed scope of work. The TABASC also **REQUESTED** that SECAS seek approval from the SEC Panel on the proposed work scope. (TABASC_78_1606_08)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with Sub-Committee updates. The TABASC **NOTED** the updates. (TABASC_78_1606_09)
- The DCC presented an update on the outcomes of the DSP Re-Procurement RFI and the transition principles for each of the proposed architectural options. The TABASC provided its feedback and **NOTED** the update. The DCC will return to a future TABASC to discuss the RFI and its outputs in greater detail. (TABASC_78_1606_10)
- The DCC provided a summary of its investigation into the December 21 2021 incident, in regard to HTTP timeouts on the DSP systems. The TABASC **NOTED** the outputs of the DCC investigation, **AGREED** to close two of the three related actions, and **NOTED** it would consider the DCC's justification for making proposed changes prior to the DCC consulting Users on them. - The DCC provided an interim update on its investigations into OTA failures. The TABASC **NOTED** the update, and requested that the DCC return with a final update once investigations and work with TSIRS has been completed. (TABASC_78_1606_13)
