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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 80 Headlines on 4 August 2022

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_80_0408_01).

The following items were also discussed:

- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on [MP122B Operational Metrics Pt 2](#). The TABASC **REVIEWED** the proposed changes and **REQUESTED** that SECAS provide feedback to the Working Group in regard to requiring a consistent solution between both CSP regions. (TABASC_80_0408_02).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the changes to [MP169 Managing SEC Obligations and the Consumer's Right to refuse a Smart Meter](#). The TABASC provided feedback that despite the proposed solution, the energy supplier and any gaining supplier will still need to take all reasonable steps in ensuring the energy consumer has a smart meter. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_80_0408_03).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the results from the DCC's Preliminary Assessment for [MP134B Use of SMKI Certificates Relating to a SoLR Event Part 2](#) and **REQUESTED** SECAS provided feedback to the Working Group to consider a solution which as a minimum allows the use of 2.1 & 1.6 SRVs and consider whether any additional SRPs used in previous SOLR instances which dealt with the continuity of supply risk would be beneficial (TABASC_80_0408_04).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Q1 Lookback Report. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_80_0408_05).
- SECAS presented the results from the Elective Communication Survey RFI. The TABASC **NOTED** the results and **AGREED** that no further work was required. (TABASC_80_0408_06).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with a Summary from the [SSES Consultation](#). The TABASC provided feedback and **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_80_0408_08).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on the scope of work as a result of BSC Modification P430 being withdrawn. The TABASC **AGREED** the amendments and **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_80_0408_09).
- The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on the Candidate Features List on the CH&N Roadmap. The DCC agreed to continue to assess the list and return to the TABASC at a future meeting and provide further updates. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_80_0408_10).
- The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on CSP North Scaling & Optimisation, with a high-level overview of the work that has taken place in Phase 1 of the programme, which the TABASC **NOTED**. (TABASC_80_0408_11).
- As part of AOB, the DCC presented their new proposals for further Outage Windows to re-run the network replacement activity. The TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC return with their reasoning why establishing a full replacement network infrastructure was not considered viable. The TABASC **AGREED** that DCC had a lot of work to mitigate risk of a failure occurring again and were supportive of the revised approach but **NOTED** that it was unable to assess the technical details of the proposed approach due to a lack of information.
