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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 83 Headlines on 3 November 2022

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_83_0311_01).

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC provided the TABASC with an executive summary of its investigation into the performance of both Service Requests and associated alerts for OTA related requests from its Technical Operations Centre (TOC) data. The TABASC **NOTED** the update and **REQUESTED** the DCC return with the latest data and outcome following the November TSIRS meeting. (TABASC_83_0311_02).
- The DCC presented the TABASC with a detailed update on both the technical and non-technical options and their merits as part of Phase 2 of the CSP.N Scaling and Optimisation activity. The TABASC **PROVIDED** its feedback on these options and **NOTED** that there was general agreement with the DCC's proposed approach. (TABASC_83_0311_03).
- The DCC provided an update on the CH&N programme as well as confirming DCC will not deliver Lot 1 as part of the programme. The TABASC **QUERIED** as to how it could most appropriately provide its technical feedback on some of the design considerations for Lot 2 and **REQUESTED** the DCC return with an engagement plan outlining where the DCC will seek TABASC involvement. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_83_0311_04).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on [MP184 'Increase Smart Capability of SMETS2 Twin Element ESME to support Solar and Storage use cases'](#). The TABASC **NOTED** that significant cross code changes will be required to fulfil the requirements as specified and **QUERIED** the use case of the modification. TANASC **NOTED** that further work needs to take place between the proposer and SECAS in understanding the details of the use case as well as the cross-code impact. (TABASC_83_0311_07).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on [MP152 Consumption on Smart Polyphase Electricity Meters](#). The TABASC **QUERIED** the use case of the modification and **NOTED** that further work needs to take place between the proposer and SECAS in understanding the details of the use case. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_83_0311_08).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on [MP172 Reduced CPA & CPL requirements for innovation and Device field trials](#). The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_83_0311_09).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with an update on the proposed options for the hosting of the Business Architecture Model. The TABASC **PROVIDED** an initial preference for the tool to continue to be hosted in its current form but **REQUESTED** that SECAS gather use-data and investigate other pragmatic application and hosting options. SECAS **AGREED** to provide an update at a future TABASC meeting. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_83_0311_10).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Lookback Report for Q2 22-23 (Jul-Sept). The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_83_0311_11).
