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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 85 Headlines on 5 January 2023

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_85_0501_01). The DCC **AGREED** to downgrade the classification of the discussion of agenda items 2 and 6 from Amber to Green, from the TABASC 84 meeting. The meeting materials remain at their original Amber classification.

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC provided the TABASC with the proposed approach to its technical refresh activity for the majority of 2023, taking into consideration the lessons learned from previous attempts. The TABASC **NOTED** the proposed schedule and the update. (TABASC_85_0501_02)
- The DCC did not provide an update on CSP.N Scaling and Optimisation as the Preliminary Assessment of the chosen technical options had not been returned in time for the TABASC 85 meeting. (TABASC_85_0501_04)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with a High-Level diagram of the solution proposed for [SECMP0028 'Prioritising System Messages'](#) and explained the relationship between SECMP0028 and other in-flight changes which are related to the prioritisation of DCC traffic. The TABASC **NOTED** the update and the DCC **AGREED** to return to a future TABASC meeting with a concise view of SECMP0028, SECMP0208 and other capacity management considerations. (TABASC_85_0501_05)
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Preliminary Assessment for [MP216 'Incorporation of Category 2 Issue Resolution Proposals into the SEC – Batch 9'](#). The TABASC **NOTED** the update and **AGREED** with the DCC assessment that there is no DCC system change required for this Modification. (TABASC_85_0501_07)
- DCC requested that SECAS defer the presentation on [MP214 'Clarification of Acceptable DCC User IDs for Import and Export Suppliers'](#), as investigations are ongoing at the DCC and an update will be provided at a future TABASC. (TABASC_85_0501_08)
- The TABASC **REQUESTED** SECAS to review its CPA Certificate renewal guidance in the CPL documentation for the scenario which covers the event of a Device CPA Certificate expiring and being replaced with a lifetime CPA Certificate. (TABASC_85_0501_09)
