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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 88 Headlines on 6 April 2023

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_88_0604_01).

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC presented its proposals for Communications Hub (CH) Order Management System (OMS) & Logistics to implement its to-be OMS in order to replace the 2G and 3G OMS currently in place. The TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC provide further clarification on when existing 2G and 3G CH orders will be transitioned to orders for the new 4G CH, along with how this will take place. (TABASC_88_0604_02).
- The DCC presented its proposals for the System Engineering Approach at DCC noting their plan to align their approach with the International Council on Systems Engineering (INCOSE) standard and make use of the BiZZDesign tool. The TABASC **NOTED** the update. (TABASC_88_0604_03).
- SECAS presented the DCC's Preliminary Assessment of MP169 Managing SEC Obligations and the Consumer's Right to refuse a Smart Meter. The TABASC **QUERIED** the business requirements and their impact on the costs of the proposed solution. The TABASC also **QUERIED** the list of restricted Service Requests and asked SECAS to review whether these met the business requirements. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_88_0604_06).
- SECAS presented an update on MP168 – CPL Security Improvements and its proposed solution. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_88_0604_07).
- SECAS presented an update on DP226 – Incorporation of Category 3 Issue Resolution Proposals into the SEC – Batch 10. SECAS **NOTED** two of these IRPs have been reclassified as document only changes. TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_88_0604_08).
