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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 89 Headlines on 4 May 2023

The following items were discussed:

- The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on the DSP Re-Procurement Northbound User Gateway Options for the to-be DSP, articulating its User benefits of Options 1 and 2. Furthermore, the DCC proposed a hybrid Option 3, a combination of Options 1 and 2 and agreed to return to TABASC with further clarification on all impacts and costs associated with these options and its relation to the DSP re-procurement activity. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_02).
- The DCC presented an update on its Testing Automation Framework (TAF) to the TABASC. The DCC provided an account of its ongoing progress and proposed that it would return to a future TABASC meeting to provide a better understanding of the high-level business architecture associated with the changes introduced to testing as a result of the TAF programme. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_03).
- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on its Network Traffic Management – Northbound Prioritisation solution. The DCC presented the proposed priority alerts list and the TABASC **QUERIED** the reasoning behind these proposals and recommended that the audience of the consultation is broadened outside of the TABASC. The DCC agreed to return to the TABASC with an update when the consultation response deadline has been passed. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_04).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Q4 Lookback Report and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_07).
- SECAS presented the proposed 2024 SEC Release Landscape. The TABASC **QUERIED** whether the modifications would be better implemented in a single release and **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_08).
- SECAS presented an update on MP235 Enhanced Meter Data Access for Other Users. The TABASC **QUERIED** the business requirements and requested clarity on the consumer benefit which would be gained from implementing this modification noting there are alternative options to obtain the data (TABASC_89_0405_09).
- SECAS presented an update on MP223 WAN Coverage Reporting. The TABASC **QUERIED** the modifications business requirements and the level of detail to be provided by new reports which are being proposed via the modification. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_89_0405_10).
