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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 94X Headlines on 19 October 2023

The following items were discussed:

- The DCC returned to the TABASC to highlight its high-level requirements for DSP Data Systems reprourement. The DCC collected feedback on both the newly introduced and existing high-level requirements. This feedback will be considered by the DCC prior to submitting these high-level requirements as part of its procurement process. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_94X_1910_01).
- The DCC provided the TABASC with answers in response to actions TABASC86X/02, TABASC91/CONF01, TABASC93/02 and TABASC89/CONF02. The TABASC **AGREED** to close actions TABASC86X/02 and TABASC91/CONF01 and **REQUESTED** that TABASC93/02 and TABASC89/CONF02 remain open, (TABASC_94X_1910_02).
- The DCC provided an update on its Communication Hubs (CHs) & Networks programme, in particular, the application of the DUIS 5.3 version and other alternatives when managing installation of 4G CHs. The DCC **AGREED** to provide further clarity on the impacts for its Customers who will use versions of DUIS earlier than 5.3 at a future TABASC meeting. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_94X_1910_03).
- The DCC provided an update on its 4G service retirement risk and upgrade approach and presented a timeline for its device strategy post 4G. The TABASC **QUERIED** the DCC's current strategic position for keeping up to date with the advancement of technology and the TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC returns with a long-term strategic communication plan. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_94X_1910_04).
- SECAS returned to TABASC with an updated 'total days of resource' figure for its work to create the Technical Specifications Applicability Tables and Intended Behaviour guidance document and the TABASC **AGREED** the new figure. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_94X_1910_05).
