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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 98 Headlines on 01 February 2024

At each meeting, the TABASC agrees the previous month's minutes and reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_98_0102_01).

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on its DSP Core Requirements following feedback at the TABASC 97 meeting. TABASC members **REQUESTED** that the DCC return to a future meeting with focus on migration. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_02).
- The DCC returned to the TABASC with an update on its Future Service Management (FSM) Requirements and Options Analysis. The TABASC **QUERIED** the DCC's reasoning behind why the options presented did not consider the impact of the API gateway or other methods of connection regarding the FSM. The TABASC also queried why the FSM had to be implemented before the new DSP core system. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_03).
- Following its CH&N Consultation on changes to the ICHIS, the DCC presented its proposed approach to address any concerns raised. TABASC members **QUERIED** the DCC's proposed timeline for proving its approach especially regarding any testing requirements and **REQUESTED** that the DCC provide a more detailed plan of activity. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_04).
- The DCC presented an update on its work regarding SMETS1 DCO Enduring High Level requirements and subsequent business needs. The DCC noted that the high-level requirements require signing off and noted that the deadline for obtaining feedback from TABASC members is 9 February 2024. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_05).
- The DCC presented the outputs of its CTO Review: Northbound Prioritisation. The TABASC **REQUESTED** that the DCC return to a future meeting to better illustrate what the current data is indicating. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_06).
- The TABASC presented an update on its progress with using the BizzDesign tool as part of its CTO activity. The DCC provided a live demonstration of the tool and the TABASC **QUERIED** how any new solutions put forward by the DCC could be analysed by the tool. The TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_07).
- SECAS presented its Q3 2023-24 Lookback Report and the TABASC **NOTED** the update (TABASC_98_0102_10.)
