SECCB_26_2301_01 - SECMP0018 'Standard Electricity Distributor Configuration Settings'

The Change Board voted to **APPROVE** <u>SECMP0018</u> 'Standard Electricity Distributor Configuration <u>Settings'</u> under Self-Governance on the basis that it would better facilitate SEC Objective (a)¹.

SECCB_26_2301_02 - SECMP0043 'Modification to Services Force Majeure Provisions'

The Change Board voted to recommend to the Authority that <u>SECMP0043</u> 'Modification to <u>Services</u> <u>Force Majeure Provisions</u>' be **REJECTED** on the basis that it would not better facilitate the SEC Objectives.

SECCB_26_2301_03 – SECMP0059 'Amendments to SEC Security Assessments for Non-Domestic Suppliers and Other Users'

The Change Board voted to **APPROVE** <u>SECMP0059</u> 'Amendments to <u>SEC Security Assessments for Non-Domestic Suppliers and Other Users'</u> under Self-Governance on the basis that it would better facilitate SEC Objective (b)² and (g)³.

What happens next?

In the case of **SECMP0018** and **SECMP0059**, which have been progressed as Path 3 'Self-Governance' modifications, there will now be 10 Working Days for any SEC Party who wishes to refer the Change Board's decisions to the SEC Panel. This referral period will close at **5pm on Wednesday 6 February 2019**.

If no referrals are received by this date, then SECMP0018 will be implemented on **27 June 2019** (as part of the June 2019 SEC Release) and SECMP0059 will be implemented on **28 February 2019** (as part of the February 2019 SEC Release).
