SECCB_27_2002_01 – SECMP0039 'Communication Hub returns notification mechanism for Other SEC Parties'

The Change Board voted to **APPROVE** <u>SECMP0039</u> 'Communication <u>Hub returns notification</u> <u>mechanism for Other SEC Parties'</u> under Self-Governance on the basis that it would better facilitate SEC Objectives (a)¹, (d)² and (h)³.

What happens next?

In the case of **SECMP0039**, which has been progressed as a Path 3 'Self-Governance' modification, there will now be 10 Working Days for any SEC Party who wishes to refer the Change Board's decision to the SEC Panel. This referral period will close at **5pm on Wednesday 6 March 2019**.

If no referrals are received by this date, then SECMP0039 will be implemented on **7 November 2019** (as part of the November 2019 SEC Release).
