1. SECCB_27_2002_01 – SECMP0039

[SECMP0039 'Communication Hub returns notification mechanism for Other SEC Parties'](#) seeks to allow all SEC Parties who order Communication Hubs a mechanism to notify the DCC of fault or no fault returns and receive appropriate responses, thus enabling all ordering Parties to execute a complete ordering and returns process.

No further comments were raised by Change Board members and the Change Board proceeded to vote.

Change Board Vote on SECMP0039:

The voting outcome is shown below:

The view of the Change Board is that will better facilitate SEC Objectives (a)¹ and (d)². Two members raised that they believe the modification also better facilitates SEC Objective (h)³. One Large Supplier member raised that they would support the provision of further detail to support the solution which could address their concerns.

An Other SEC Party member questioned the level of DCC cost to implement the modification.

The Network Party members abstained, believing this to be a matter for Suppliers and Other SEC Parties to determine.

The Change Board:

- **AGREED** that SECMP0039 should proceed to vote;
- **DETERMINED** that SECMP0039 should be **APPROVED** under Self-Governance; and
- **PROVIDED** rationale for this decision against the General SEC Objectives.

SECMP0039 has been progressed as a Path 3 'Self-Governance' modification, there will now be 10 Working Days for any SEC Party who wishes to refer the Change Board's decision to the SEC Panel. This referral period will close at **5pm on Wednesday 6 March 2019**.

If no referrals are received by this date, then SECMP0039 will be implemented on **7 November 2019** (as part of the November 2019 SEC Release).
