## **Decision Papers**

SECCB\_28\_2703\_01 - SECMP0069 'EU Exit Changes'

The Change Board voted to **APPROVE** <u>SECMP0069 'EU Exit Changes'</u> under Self-Governance on the basis that it would better facilitate SEC Objective (g)<sup>1</sup>.

SECCB\_28\_2703\_02 – SECMP0070 'Permission to give Alt HAN Forum vires for enduring management and maintenance of the Exempt Premises List (EPL)'

The Change Board voted to **APPROVE** <u>SECMP0070</u> 'Permission to give Alt HAN Forum vires for <u>enduring management and maintenance of the Exempt Premises List (EPL)</u>' under Self-Governance on the basis that it would better facilitate SEC Objective (h)<sup>2</sup>.

### What happens next?

Both modifications have been progressed as Self-Governance Modifications, and so there will now be 10 Working Days for any SEC Party who wishes to refer the Change Board's decision to the SEC Panel. This referral period will close at **5pm on Wednesday 10 April 2019**.

If no referrals are received by this date, then **SECMP0069** will be implemented on **UK EU Exit Day** and **SECMP0070** will be implemented on **26 April 2019** (10 Working Days after the referral period closes).
