Change Board vote

About this document

This document summarises the discussions of the Change Board on SECMP0069 and the outcome of the vote.

This vote forms a decision on SECMP0069 under Self-Governance.

1. Change Board discussions

Views and discussions on the proposal

The Change Board noted a comment that had been raised on the legal text, proposing that the wording in Section I1.7(g) should be aligned with the wording in the DCC Licence. SECAS confirmed this would be a housekeeping change with no material impact. The Change Board were happy to include this amendment in the final legal text, and so Annex A of the Modification Report has been updated to include this change.

Views against the General SEC Objectives

Objective (g)¹

The Change Board believes that SECMP0069 will better facilitate SEC Objective (g), by allowing any references in the SEC to EU Law to be removed or changed to bring the SEC in line with UK Law.
