Meeting Summary

Discussions of the Working Group

SECAS gave an overview of the modification’s aims and solution; these can be found on the modification’s webpage and in the meeting materials.

Consideration of the Modification Proposal

The other members of the Working Group were invited to discuss whether they had also experienced the same issue as the Proposer with the time constraints. Other Suppliers stated that they have not had any issue with the 48-hour timeframe. The majority of the Working Group agreed that the ideal period for the ASN is 2-3 days – any longer would become a potential drawback in the logistical process for Suppliers as well as the DCC.

Review of the Business Requirements

It was discussed that the business requirements would need to be amended to ascertain how many days the period can increase by until the DCC would need to think about constructing a new warehouse to store the larger quantity of Communications Hubs and hence the costs would increase substantially.

The Working Group agreed that the business requirements should be amended to calculate the cost increase when varying the timescale extension.

Next Steps

SECAS will now update the business requirements and submit them to the DCC for Preliminary Assessment.
