


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MP071 'Second-Comer Charging' Modification Report Consultation responses

EDF Energy	Large Supplier	Approve	We agree that MP071 better facilitates SEC Objective (g) as it aligns the content of the SEC with the actual operation of the DCC.
			We believe that this change is neutral against the other SEC Objectives, including Objective (a) – there is no evidence that this improves the actual operation of smart metering.
Scottish Power	Large Supplier	Approve	We agree that Objective (a) would be better facilitated by the implementation of MP071 in that, by improving the efficiency with which a Gateway connection is provided, it will better affect the operation of Smart Metering Systems.
			We also agree that its implementation would better facilitate Objective (g) in that we would expect SEC Section K to be more efficiently discharged as a result.
