Decision, Discussion and Information Items

1. Minutes and Actions Outstanding (For Information)

The Panel noted that the minutes from the September 2019 Panel meeting had been approved excommittee. It was noted that all actions marked as Complete and Propose to Close could be closed.

The Panel NOTED the update.

2. SEC Panel Budget Timetable (For Decision)

SECAS provided the Panel with an outline timetable for the preparation of the SEC Panel Draft Budget and associated work plan for 2021-2023. As in previous years, SECAS proposed to engage with the Panel Finance and Contracts Group (PFCG) to develop the Draft Budget.

The Panel **AGREED** for SECAS to hold discussions with the PFCG on initial drafting and **APPROVED** the timetable for the development of the budget.

3. Code Administrators Performance Survey Outcomes (For Information)

SECAS presented the Panel with an overview of the outcomes of the Code Administrators performance survey.
