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Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting Headlines on 21 November 2019

At each meeting, the TABASC receives updates from the DCC, BEIS and other Sub-Committees on matters of relevance to the TABASC. The TABASC also review its Activity Planner (TABASC_48_2111_09) and Risk Register and Issues Log (TABASC_48_2111_06) monthly to ensure these are up to date.

Alongside these items, the following items were discussed:

- DCC updates concerning:
 - [SECMP0062 'Northbound Application Traffic Management – Alert Storm Protection' solution](#) and [SECMP0067 'Service Request Traffic Management'](#) (TABASC_48_2111_02);
 - Alternative solutions to T3 aerials, extending duration of 2G Coverage and LTE Communications Hubs highlighting that there are a set of principles developed with the outcome of a new national network capability to deliver DCC's strategic programme (TABASC_48_2111_03); and
 - CSP North Scalability Approach highlighting the capacity modelling predictions and noting that new hardware will be deployed in 2020 which will provide additional capacity (TABASC_48_2111_04).
- SECAS noted that the CPL Enhancement Project delivery was delayed, and the project cost has overrun. The developer has re-planned the programme in order to accommodate the extra work required. (TABASC_48_2111_08).
- SECAS provided the TABASC with the Effectiveness Review Responses highlighting the key findings and actionable next steps (TABASC_48_2111_10).
- TABASC discussed projects that relate to it within the SEC Strategic Plan, which feeds into the budget consultation. The TABASC confirmed support for activities, provided input into the budget, and refined the cost and probability of activities (TABASC_48_2111_13).
- The TABASC expressed its interest, to the [MP88 'Power to raise Modifications'](#) Working Group, in having provisions to raise new Proposals as a Sub-Committee.
- SECAS provided the TABASC with an overview of the changes to the DCC Release Management Policy (TABASC_48_2111_07).
