MP084 Refinement Consultation

1. Purpose

This is the Refinement Consultation for [MP084 'Other User Panel Seating Amendment'](#). We invite you to respond to this consultation in order to help the Proposer in the development of this modification.

The draft Modification Report is included in this consultation pack, along with a response form containing the questions we seek your views on.

This consultation will close at **17:00 on Friday 3 January 2020**. We may not be able to consider late responses.

2. Summary of the proposal

What is the issue?

Currently, the SEC Panel has two seats to be occupied by Other SEC Parties. However, because Other SEC Parties aren't always Other Users, this may lead to Other Users being underrepresented. A SEC Panel questionnaire was issued in April 2019 and the outcomes discussed at SEC Panel in June 2019 to gauge opinion. It was suggested that an Other User seat should be added to the Panel to ensure the Other Users are proportionately and fairly represented.

What is the Proposed Solution?

Under this proposal the two Other SEC Party seats will be split so there will be one Other SEC Party seat and one Other User seat on the Panel.

Are there any Alternative Solutions?

One Alternative Solution has been raised, which is proposing to keep the two Other SEC Party Seats and add an Other User Seat.

Will I be impacted?

MP084 is expected to impact the following SEC Parties:

- Other Users
