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## Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting Headlines on 5 March 2020

At each meeting, the TABASC receives updates from the DCC, BEIS and other Sub-Committees on matters of relevance to the TABASC. The TABASC also reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC\_51\_0503\_01) and was provided with its Risk Register and Issues Log (TABASC\_51\_0503\_12) for information this month.

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC provided the TABASC with an update on its Network Evolution approach, which seeks to mitigate the risk of Communications Hubs potentially not reaching the end of their commercial life due to lack of supporting 2G mobile services. DCC is still considering technical and implementation options to be included in the business case. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_02)
- The DCC provided the TABASC with an update on its Data Service Provider (DSP) Sandpit for the Network Evolution project. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_03)
- The DCC provided the TABASC with its proposal to expand the GFI Test Tools to cover the overarching DCC ecosystem, including supporting DCC customers with Electric Vehicle and Proportional Load control propositions. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_04)
- The TABASC continued to consider the issue raised by EUK for minimising Alerts lost during DCC Scheduled Maintenance. The reliability of HAN communications and the alerts deemed critical by Service Users were also assessed. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_06)
- The TABASC agreed to request that the SEC Panel write to Ofgem and the Elexon Working Group for Multiple Supplier per Meter Point Administration Number (MPAN), to raise the TABASC concerns. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_07)
- The TABASC recommended the Work Package for Q1 2020-21 (Apr – Jun) to the SECCo Board for approval but noted it may be subject to change due to additional resourcing required over Q1. The work package included the forecast for Core Resource and projects. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_11)
- [DP098 'Incorporation of multiple Issue Resolution Proposals into the SEC – Batch 3'](#) was discussed and TABASC provided views on the approach to just implement the modification in GBCS v4.0 subject to their being no material benefit to Devices. (TABASC\_51\_0503\_14)
- The TABASC noted SECAS' update on the new Draft Proposals and Modification Proposals raised since the February meeting, specifically providing views on the [SECMP80 'Managing DUIS uplifts'](#). (TABASC\_51\_0503\_16).
