This document summarises the responses received to the Modification Report Consultation and the decision of the Change Board regarding approval or rejection of this modification.

Summary of conclusions

Change Board

The Change Board voted to **approve** MP098. It believed the modification better facilitates SEC Objective (a).

Modification Report Consultation

SECAS received two responses to the Modification Report Consultation. Both respondents believe the modification should be approved. It was stated that the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a).

Modification Report Consultation responses

Summary of responses

The two respondents both stated that the adding the Issue Resolution Proposals (IRPs) included in MP098, which have already received industry support, provide clarity and corrections to the technical specifications. This is critical in ensuring a reduction in ambiguity to those building and operating smart equipment in the market. As a result of this, both respondents believed that the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a).
