Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 65 Headlines on 6 May 2021

At each meeting, the TABASC reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_65_0605_01). The TABASC approved the minutes from the 64 meeting as final.

The following items were also discussed:

- The DCC provided the TABASC with the Network Evolution Data Service Provider (DSP)
 Requirements, noting that the Business Requirements Document and a summary of the
 proposed changes will be provided for review by members prior to the TABASC 65X meeting.
 (TABASC_65_0605_02).
- The DCC provided the TABASC with an overview of the SEC Modifications which will be implemented as part of Network Evolution. The TABASC requested that the DCC return to a future meeting with an implementation approach. (TABASC_65_0605_03).
- The TABASC provided views and feedback on the SECAS overview of BSCMP375 and associated next steps, the TABASC endorsed establishing a Project for SECAS to develop an integrated SMETS solution to COP11 and SECAS will prepare a scoping document for TABASC 66. (TABASC_65_0605_04).
- SECAS provided the TABASC with the enhancements which have been made to the Central Products List (CPL) tool. One TABASC Member volunteered to undertake a practice run of the enhanced CPL from a submitter perspective before go-live. The TABASC agreed the changes to the process should be clearly communicated to stakeholders in advance of golive. (TABASC 65 0605 06).
- SECAS provided the TABASC with the Lookback Report against the Q4 2020-21 (January March) Work Package. The TABASC noted the update. (TABASC_65_0605_07).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Business Requirements for MP125A 'Correcting Device Information ESME Variant. The TABASC provided feedback on the Business Requirements and SECAS advised it will circulate the updated Business Requirements to TABASC Members ex-committee. (TABASC_65_0605_08).
- SECAS presented the draft proposal for <u>DP158 'Incorporation of multiple Issue Resolution Proposals into the SEC Batch 5'</u>, which is targeted for implementation in November 2021. (TABASC_65_0605_09).
- SECAS presented the business requirements for MP134B 'Use of SMKI Certificates relating to a SoLR event Part 2', which the TABASC endorsed. (TABASC_65_0605_10).
- SECAS provided the draft proposal for <u>DP157 'Removal of DUIS v1.0 and v2.0'</u>, which the TABASC provided feedback on and requested that this modification does not progress to the CSC until the requirements are agreed by the TABASC. (TABASC_65_0605_11).
- The DCC provided the TABASC with an update from its Chief Technology Officer (CTO), for information only. (TABASC_65_0605_13).
- The TABASC agreed that SECAS should undertake the actions presented as part of the review into the Market-Wide Half Hourly Settlements questionnaire results. (TABASC_65_0605_14).
