Summary of conclusions

Change Board

The Change Board voted to **approve** MP099. It believed the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a)¹.

Modification Report Consultation

The Smart Energy Code Administrator and Secretariat (SECAS) received one response to the Modification Report Consultation. The respondent believed the modification should be approved. The respondent agreed [MP099 ‘Incorporation of multiple Issue Resolution Proposals into the SEC – Batch 4’](#) better facilitated SEC objective (a) as it will ensure the efficient provision, installation and operation, as well as interoperability, of Smart Metering Systems at Energy Consumers premises within Great Britain.
