Technical Architecture and Business Architecture Sub-Committee (TABASC) Meeting 66 Headlines on 3 June 2021

At each meeting, the TABASC reviews the actions outstanding (TABASC_66_0306_01). The TABASC approved the minutes from the 65 meeting as final.

The following items were also discussed:

- SECAS presented the TABASC with the final report for Use Cases 1-3 of the Strategic Technical Design Project, noting the options for Electric Vehicles, Distributed Energy Resource and Internet of Things. (TABASC_66_0306_02).
- The TABASC provided views and feedback on the BSCMP375 project brief presented by SECAS. The TABASC requested that SECAS return with the scope expanded to identify a list of business process' it believes will be impacted, as part of the gap analysis. (TABASC_66_0306_04).
- SECAS provided the TABASC with an overview of the activities and associated resource requirements for the SECAS Core Team and Subject Matter Experts for the period 1 July – 30 September 2021. The TABASC recommended the Work Package for SECCo Board approval. (TABASC_66_0306_05).
- SECAS presented the draft proposal for [DP162 'SEC changes required to deliver MHHS'](#) which the TABASC provided its initial feedback on. (TABASC_66_0306_06).
- SECAS presented the TABASC with the Business Requirements for [MP128 'Gas Network Operators SMKI Requirements'](#). The TABASC provided feedback on the Business Requirements and requested some further investigations before the modification moves to Preliminary Assessment. (TABASC_66_0306_07).
- SECAS provided the draft proposal for [DP157 'Removal of DUIS v1.0 and v2.0'](#), which the TABASC supported but requested to review the legal text before the modification progresses. (TABASC_66_0306_08).
- The DCC provided the TABASC with an introduction to the Data Service Provider (DSP) Business Requirements Document. The TABASC requested that a new version of the Business Requirements including the updates requested by the TABASC is sent to Members at least one week ahead of the meeting on 17 June, along with a letter explaining what is expected from TABASC Members on this item at the 17 June meeting. - The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on the DSP extension, for information purposes only. (TABASC_66_0306_11).
- The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on Communication Hub and Network Procurement, noting where there may be delays to the timelines and the reasoning for this. (TABASC_66_0306_12).
- The DCC presented the TABASC with an update on Communication Service Provider (CSP) North Scalability, noting an update on the Over The Air (OTA) enhancement delivery. (TABASC_66_0306_13).
