This document summarises the responses received to the Modification Report Consultation and the decision of the Change Board regarding approval or rejection of this modification.

Summary of conclusions

Change Board

The Change Board voted to **approve** MP141. It believed the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a)¹.

Modification Report Consultation

SECAS received five responses to the Modification Report Consultation. All five respondents believed that the modification should be approved. They considered the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a).

¹ Facilitate the efficient provision, installation, operation and interoperability of smart metering systems at energy consumers' premises within Great Britain.

Modification Report Consultation responses

Summary of responses

All five respondents believed that the modification should be approved as it would provide SEC Parties with greater visibility of Service Request Variant (SRV) traffic against Devices for which they are the Relevant Supplier or is on their Network. They believed this would assist with different triage scenarios and understanding specific Device behaviour when investigating behaviour of problem Devices. They further believed this would aid the User in investigating any erratic behaviour of affected Devices and help identify root cause issues and resolutions, thus leading to more efficient use of the smart metering system.

Overall, the response to the implementation of this modification was positive with no objections raised in the Modification Report Consultation
