About this document

This document summarises the responses received to the Modification Report Consultation and the decision of the Change Board regarding approval or rejection of this modification.

Summary of conclusions

Change Board

The Change Board voted to **approve** MP178. It believed the modification better facilitated SEC Objective (a)¹.

Modification Report Consultation

SECAS received three responses to the Modification Report Consultation. All respondents believed that the modification should be approved. They considered the modification better facilitated SEC Objectives (a) and $(c)^2$.

Modification Report Consultation responses

Summary of responses

Two respondents (Large Suppliers) considered the modification positively impact SEC Objective (a) and one believed that it positively impacted SEC Objective (c), commenting that the solution proposed will effectively resolve the issue with little business impact. Another respondent (also a Large Supplier) deemed this modification as a sensible change, noting that all queries had been answered through the modification process.
