Summary of SECMP0031 and SECMP0038 Working Group Meeting

- SECAS to ask DCC to provide the costs for where commands are sent back to the Supplier and for when commands are not sent back to the Supplier via the PPMID, in intermittent WAN situations.
- SECAS to seek views from SSC on the proposed solution for SECMP0038 and the suggestion of utilising a non-CPA accredited device to send and receive commands in intermittent WAN situations.
- SECAS to check with BEIS and Ofgem that no group is actively working on a no-WAN solution. Should work already be developed or in motion, for updates to be provided to the Working Group and for opportunities of collaboration to be sought.
- SECAS to confirm attendance for a new Issues Group to be formed within the next month (September/ October) and to combine this meeting with another Working Group for SECMP0038, allowing the same people to attend both meetings.
- DCC to update the Preliminary Assessment for SECMP0038 following the answers to the clarification questions and comments from the Working Group.
- SECMP0031 could be withdrawn with a new issue raised to cover the 'no-WAN' situation and how to send commands in these scenarios.
- SECMP0031/38 to agree on the definition of "intermittent WAN" and "no-WAN".
